The Kimble County Groundwater Conservation District will hold a public hearing on proposed rule as described below on Monday, August 4, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. at the District Office, 731 Main Street, Suite B, Junction, Texas.

All citizens are invited to attend and may inspect the proposed rule changes, and a copy of the current rules at the District office, Tuesdays, or Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. until August 4th. A description of the changes proposed are the following:

1. Section 1: Definitions and General Provisions
 - Added definitions: 1.101(10) Aquifer Test, 1.101(67) Retail Public Utility, 1.101(68) Retail Water Utility Service, 1.101(69) Subdivision of a Groundwater Reservoir, 1.101(71) Total Irrigated Acreage, 1.101(72) Total Reservoir Acreage, 1.101(73) Total Service Area
 - Updated Rule 1.209 District Office Location to reflect current location
2. Section 3: Well Registration and Permits, Subsection 2. Permits
 - Rule 3.204 permit application requirements
 - i. Added clarifying language to Rule 3.204(3) for location of use
 - ii. Hydrological Report Requirements – Added language describing requirements of hydrological report based on proposed permit
 - iii. Hydrological Report Requirements - Added language describing what is required to be a complete reports
 - iv. Added 3.204(d) Test Holes requirements
 - RULE 3.208 Meters for all permitted wells required and specifics of meter needed
3. Section 5: Well Spacing and Production Limits, Subsection 2. Production Limits
 - Amended Rule 5.202 Production Limits to add language regarding the District's Desired Future Condition, Management Plan and monitoring wells
4. Section 10: Enforcement
 - Rule 10.102 Enforcement Provisions were amended to add language clarifying procedures for enforcement actions and provisions, including show cause hearing procedures.
