1. Call Meeting to Order, establish a quorum.

Reginald Stapper established a quorum and called the regular business meeting to order at 6:03 pm.

2. Public Comment Period- No public was present

3. Consider, possible action to Approve Minutes of the May 19, 2025, meeting

Marvin Wilson made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 19th meeting and Joe Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried.

4. Consider, possible action to approve financial report & payment of bills

Mike Carter made a motion to approve the financial report and pay the pending bills and Clint Smith seconded. The motion carried.

5. Consider, possible action to approve suggested rule changes and set for public hearing

Meredith Allen reviewed the suggested rule change language received by the District's attorney.

Discussion was held as Director's reviewed the possible changes, including changes to the definitions section, well permit application new requirement of hydrological study based on requested use, and the proposal to require meters on all new permitted wells. The proposed rules would require spacing and production limits in compliance with the District's Desired Future Condition and Management Plan, new requirements for test holes, and Section 10: Enforcement would be amended to clarify procedures for enforcement actions. Clint Smith made a motion to approve the Proposed Rules and set for public hearing on August 4, 2025 at 6pm. Marvin Wilson seconded, and the motion carried.
