The subjects to be discussed or considered, or upon which any formal action may be taken, are listed below. Items may or may not be taken in the same order as shown on this meeting notice.

Notice of Public Hearing on Proposed Desired Future Conditions of Relevant Aquifers within the District in Groundwater Management Area 7

1. Call to order at 6:00pm
2. In accordance with the Texas Water Code 36.108, the District will receive public input at a hearing on the proposed desired future conditions (DFCs) of groundwater resources located within Groundwater Management Area 7 (GMA 7). The District's proposed DFCs for the next 50-year regional planning cycle are:

Edwards-Trinity (Plateau): average drawdown not to exceed an average of 1 foot in 2080 compared with 2010 levels

Ellenburger-San Saba: average drawdown not to exceed 18 feet in 2080 compared with 2010 levels

Hickory: average drawdown not to exceed 18 feet in 2080 compared with 2010 levels

Pursuant to Texas Water Code § 36.108(d-2), a 90-day public comment period began on May 5, 2026 which is the date the proposed DFCs were mailed to the GMA 7 districts. Comments may be submitted orally or in writing during the District's hearing or in writing to the District's office, Attention General Manager Meredith Allen, P.O, Box 31, Junction, Texas 76849. After this hearing and comment period, the District will compile for consideration at the next joint planning meeting of the GMA 7 districts a summary of relevant comments received, any suggested revisions to the proposed DFCs, and the basis for any revisions.

3. Adjourn Public Hearing on the Proposed DFCs for the Edwards-Trinity (Plateau), Ellenburger-San Saba, and Hickory Aquifers.
